Additional graduation requirements: 1 credit Philosophy(Understanding the Times), 1 credit technology, 1 credit fine arts, .5 physical education, .5 health, 1.5 credits of electives; 26.5 credits are needed for graduation Students must have a combination of 7 credits for math and science.

Fine Arts classes include: Drawing, Sculpting, Photography, Choir, Praise Team, Drama, Advance Performance

Technology classes include: Web Design, Python, Javascript, Computer Basics, Keyboarding, Theater Tech

Electives may include additional academic, fine arts or technology classes as well as Yearbook, Home Economics, Speech, and Communications

Honors classes include: Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, Anatomy and Physiology, Biology II, and Spanish III

AP classes offered in English Literature and English Language alternate years

Dual-enrollment and college classes are available during the student's senior year.

Students are counselled to take a strong schedule in preparation for the student's career direction.

Apprenticeships and Internships are available to seniors who are exploring careers that can be matched with a local business.

Grading is based on a ten point scale: 100-90 A, 89-80 B, 79-70 C, 69-60 D, 60 and below F

Co-Curricular Activities include: Student Council, Student Government, drama and choral presentations, Honor Society, 4 - H, Spirit Club, Book Club, Running Club, Archery Club, and Fellowship of Christian Athletes
